

SECOND MILER AWARD

The Second Miler award is awarded to District Scouters who have gone the second mile in implementing the program in their unit or district. Generally speaking, recipients are registered as an adult Scouter and have five years or more of service as an adult leader in BSA positions. Recipient's unit would typically be a Quality Unit. If nominee serves in multiple roles, their time of service is combined. Recipients will have sought Basic Training in their current roles. In addition, they may have completed WoodBadge Training. Recipients may have been involved in Scouting in their youth. Note: This award is chosen by the Advancement & Recognition Committee of the District. There is one award given for every ten units in the district.
