Trained leaders provide a quality, fun-filled program for Scouting units. When leaders understand Scouting, they are more effective in their roles. Please complete all of this training as soon as possible. The order listed below is the recommended order to take this training.

How Often	Training Name	Where to get it	Notes
1 time	Fast Start	myscouting.scouting.org	How Scouting works. Should be completed before meeting with any boys.
Once a year	Youth Protection	myscouting.scouting.org	Basic Information on protecting boys and leaders.
1 time	This is Scouting	myscouting.scouting.org	Background on Scouting. Should be completed prior to taking Leader Position Specific Training.
Once every 5 years OR when you have a new position	Leader Position Specific	Sponsored by the Stakes in the District (dates and places announced at roundtable), or myscouting.scouting.org	Helps you accomplish your specific responsibilities.
Once every 5 years – someone in the Pack should take it	Weather Hazards	myscouting.scouting.org	Take before outdoor activities
You should review it at last once	Read 'The Guide to Safe Scouting'	The Council Office store. (Also available online)	This guide must be present in any vehicle used for activities or tours. All leaders planning or running an activity should have read this book.
Once every 5 years – someone in the Pack should take it	Safe Swim Defense	myscouting.scouting.org	Take before swimming activities
1 time (one or the other) (someone in Webelos should have)	North Star or OWL (Outdoors Webelos Leader training)	Signup at Council Office. Also announced at Round Table	Outdoor Training for Webelos Leaders.
Every Month	Roundtable	1 st Thursday of each month	Ongoing Specific training and guidance.
