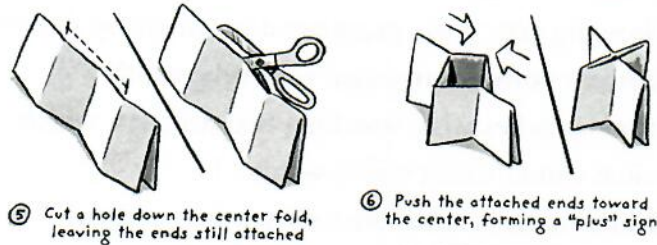
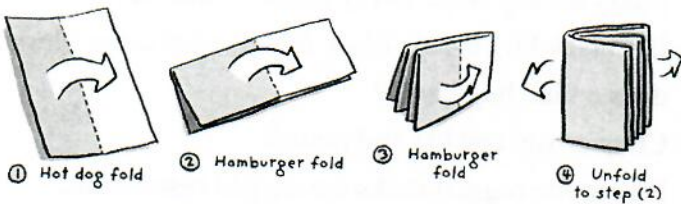




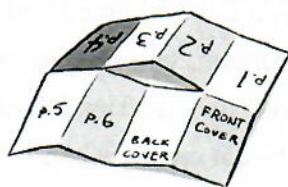
Complete the following requirements.
