HONOR TROOP REQUIREMENTS



TROOP # _____ CAMPSITE: _____

- Receive a daily average of 195 points for daily campsite visitation.
- Complete a camp service or conservation project(s) lasting at least two hours and have all troop members participate.
- The troop must function with the patrol method and each patrol must earn the Baden-Powell Award
- Camp Maple Dell should not have to deal with any discipline problems from any members of the troop. The troop must live the Scout Oath and Law.
- The Senior Patrol Leader or assistant must attend and be on time at each Senior Patrol Leader meeting.
- Participate in at least six (6) of the following activities as a troop:
 - Honor Trail with Campsite Devotional afterwards
 - At least one (1) participant in the Frontiersman Program or S.Tr.I.D.E.R. Program
 - Troop Talent Campfire with another Troop
 - Low C.O.P.E.
 - At least one (1) adult takes an adult training other than Leave No Trace
 - Friday Camp-wide Games
 - At least one (1) participant in the Trail To First Class Program
 - At least three (3) participants go on the Outpost Hike
 - Post or retrieve the Colors at a Camp-wide or Commissioner Area Ceremony
 - Joint activity with another troop (other than the Troop Talent Campfire)
- ALL members of the troop wear the complete Official Scout Uniform to ALL evening flag ceremonies and campfires. All uniforms must look neat, and the shirts be tucked into the pants. The proper uniform includes Scout Shirt, Scout Pants or Shorts, Scout Socks, and Scout Belt. Neckerchief and Hats are optional Troop Uniform items. This requirement is very important in building Troop Unity and Leadership, so be prepared before camp.
- Construct a significant pioneering project in the camp pioneering yard
- At least one leader and/or Scout must complete the Outdoor Ethics Minimal Impact Training (Leave No Trace) as a Guide while at camp.

 - All members of the Patrol wear their uniforms to a morning or evening Flag Ceremony. All uniforms must look neat, and the shirts be tucked into the pants.
6. Patrol Leaders' Council:
 - The Patrol Leader represents the Patrol at each Patrol Leaders' Council during the week.
7. Campsite Inspection:
 - Score an average of 175 on the daily campsite visitation sheet
